In the event entry limits are reached, an "overflow" judge will be assigned to judge Ducks A& B and tests for both days. Open to all AKC Registered Herding Breeds, Boxers, Samoyeds, Rottweilers, Standard & Giant Schnauzers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, dogs with ILPs in these breeds, nine months of age or older.

Notice to Exhibitors

IMPORTANT NOTICE: For the past several years, heat has been an issue for the dogs, especially their feet. Be prepared with either vet wrap or booties if your dogs tolerate them. The final decision is up to the judge but in the past, after inspecting the feet first for any existing injuries, our judges have allowed vet wrap or booties.

Bring your own canopies. Cool off tubs will be provided for dogs.**No RVs, trailers, or tents may camp at the trial site without site owner's permission.** Please bring your own chairs. **Lunch will not be available on site. Please bring your own meals. There are fast food restaurants within 15 miles of the site.** Schedule will be provided. Bitches in season will be allowed but will be moved to the end of the class or test. Please notify the Test Secretary if your bitch is in season.

ALL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB RULES REGARDING CONDUCT WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.
No refund for duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the club after closing of entries.
RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY.
NO CONDITIONAL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

A separate entry form must be completed for each dog entered. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE. You can, however, use the same entry form for both days and for more than one class and/or stock as long as all entries are for the same dog. Owners or their Agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the test/trial arena. Judges are not required to wait for dogs.

Exhibitors are expected to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent (unless replaced by an Alternate), disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Test/Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or to complete the test/trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.
