SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Handlers' briefing and course walk-through for Test 1 will begin one-half hour prior to the start of judging. The start of classes for Test 1 will be determined once entries have closed and will proceed until completed. Handlers' briefing and course walk-through for Test 2 will begin 1 hour after completion of the first test. Classes will start one-half hour after completion of the walk through and briefing. Breaks will be at the discretion of the test judges.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

FROM THE NORTH or SOUTH - Take I-25 to Exit 257A and go east on Hwy 34. Stay on the Hwy 34 Bypass until US Hwy 85 until 11th Avenue head north on 11th Ave, continue north just past 22nd St, there is a small turnout into a parking lot. Follow this parking lot and the first right follow into the parking lot for the test.

FROM EAST OR WEST - Hwy 34 toward Greeley, then follow above directions.

CONCESSIONS AND FACILITIES

There will be no running water or concessions at the test site, so be sure to bring enough water and snacks for you and your dogs. Access to a restroom in McKee Hall will be available, please know this is a bit of a walk from the test site. We will have a travel trailer on site with a restroom, please only use this if you are physically unable to make the distance to the public facilities.

Each test is limited to 30 entries. Rottweilers will be given preference.

TEST 2 MOVE-UPS AND SAME DAY ENTRIES

A dog (or team) that is entered in Test 2 in a class in which it earned a title in Test 1 will be allowed to move up to a more advanced class in Test 2 without any additional fee. Such a move-up requires written notification of the Test Secretary before the start of Test 2.

Same day entries will be allowed for Test 2. Entry form and fee as set out above, together with a \$5 same-day fee added for each Test 2 class entered must be submitted to the Test Secretary before the start of Test 2.

PERPETUAL TROPHIES

In honor of CH/UCH Brush Creek's Ewe R My Destiny, HT HCT TT RE CS CI (ARC Top 10 Carting), Jill Grant of Schmusen Rottweilers has donated the Zena Trophy, a perpetual trophy to be awarded each year to the dog with the highest combined score of that dog's best score in Test 1 and best score in Test 2. Ties will be broken by time. Teams are eligible for the award.

In honor of CAC/UCICB/UKC CH Rogue Franch's King Kong, CSst CIst RA CD HSAd TD TT (ARC Top 10 Carting, 6x HIT Carting), Jill Grant of Schmusen Rottweilers has donated the Kong Trophy, a perpetual trophy to be awarded each year to the highest-scoring veteran dog in Test 1. Ties will be broken by time. Teams are **not** eligible for the award.

CARTING TEST RULES

Each exhibitor/handler is responsible for being familiar with and complying with the complete Carting Rules of the American Rottweiler Club. Rules can be obtained at:

The test shall be open to Rottweilers (and dogs of other breeds capable of performing the test) one year of age or older. Any dog that behaves in an aggressive manner toward other dogs or people shall be excused from the test. The Rules set forth several other grounds for excusal or failure. In addition, the judge may deny participation due to ill-fitting equipment, physical unsoundness, or unruliness of dog or handler.

The carting test requires the dog and handler to negotiate a course that includes the following elements in an order and pattern determined by the Course Director: (1) hitching to cart, (2) loading 40# weight, which will be unloaded after last exercise, (3) left turn, (4) right turn, (5) stop, (6) fast, (7) slow, (8) back at least 3 feet, (9) circle left 360 degrees, (10) circle right 360 degrees, (11) serpentine consisting of 5 cones 9' apart, (12) distraction, (13) negotiating a gate with a 4' opening. Optional elements that may be included are a bridge, a figure 8, and/or an additional distraction. In addition, each dog must complete a 3-minute group down stay while hitched to cart. The course will **not** be modified to accommodate larger carts.

A perfect performance would earn a score of 200. To qualify, a dog must complete each element of the course with a passing score for that element and complete the group down stay with a total test score of at least 170.

A carting dog should move the cart with pride and eagerness yet listen to direction from the handler. The purpose of this competition is to give handlers and their dogs a chance to exhibit these skills and abilities.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Huge thanks to our exhibitors for making this test a success. We hope you have a great time and will join us on the next test.

The carting test will be held on the asphalt at Gunter Green to the east of Gunter Hall at the University of Northern Colorado.

There is plentiful parking and outdoor crating areas available. However, neither shade nor shelter is available near the carting test site. Depending on weather, **BRING YOUR OWN SHADE OR OTHER CRATE COVERS! AND REMEMBER TO CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG!**

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win titles, prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I(we) agree to hold the American Rottweiler Club ("ARC"), Mile High Rottweiler Club ("MHRC"), their members, directors, officers, agents, and event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any ARC-approved judge judging this event harm less from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of the dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I(we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I(we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to the dog.
